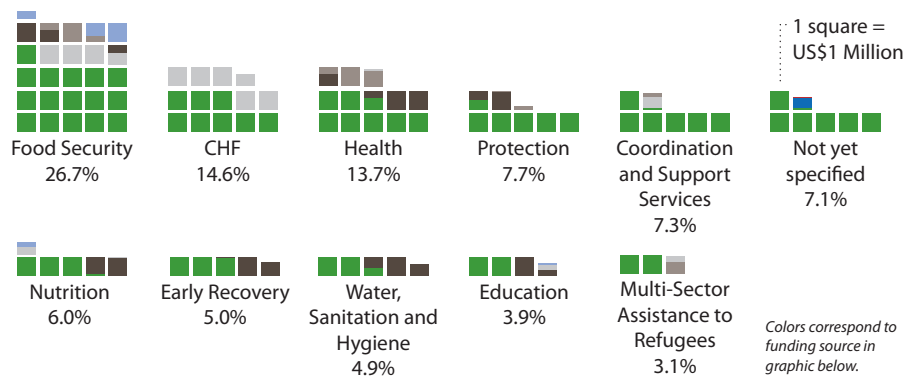
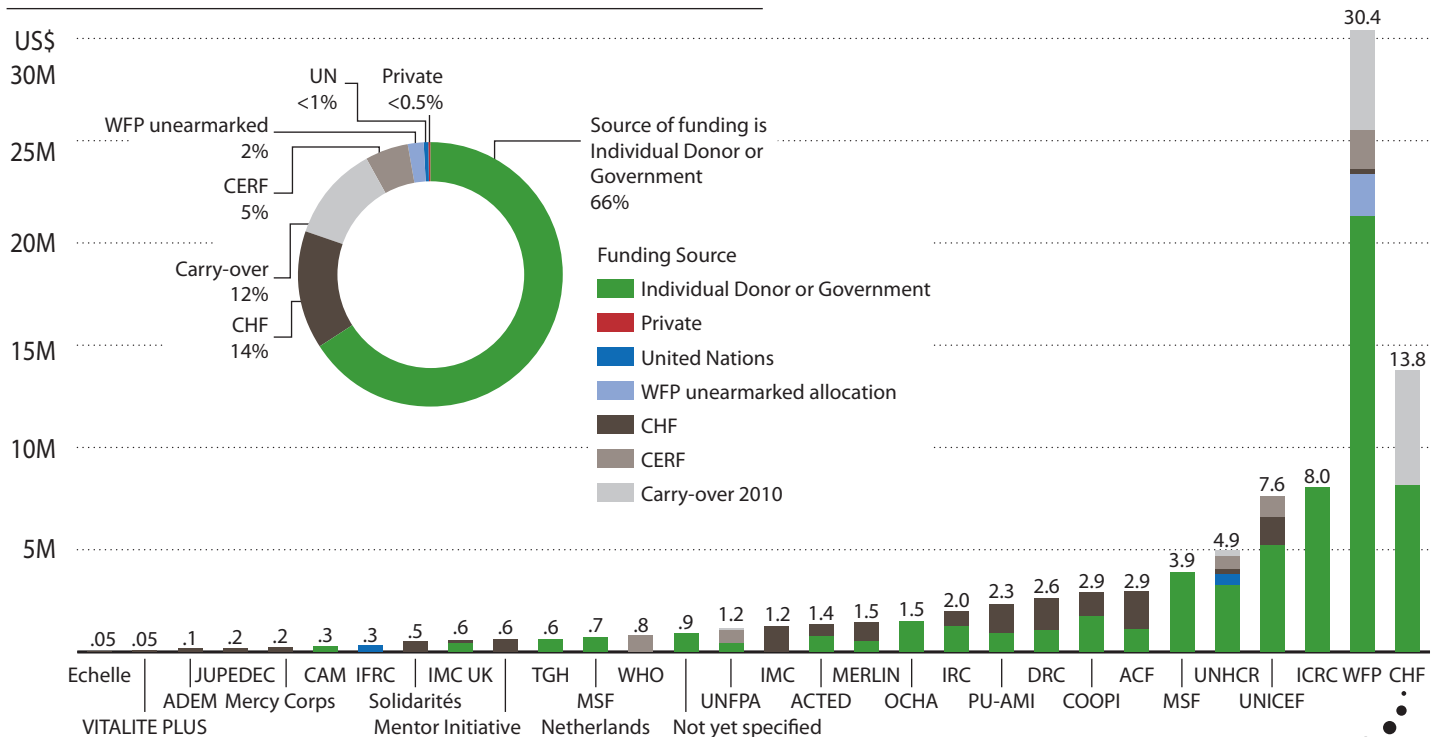


The Central African Republic (CAR) has received **US\$80.7 million** in 2011, where US\$64.0M was allocated to projects in the Consolidated Humanitarian Appeal (CAP), currently funded at **45%**. **28 organisations** received funding from more than **15 donors**. The Common Humanitarian Fund (CHF) and the Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF) have helped to cover identified priority needs not covered by individual donors.¹

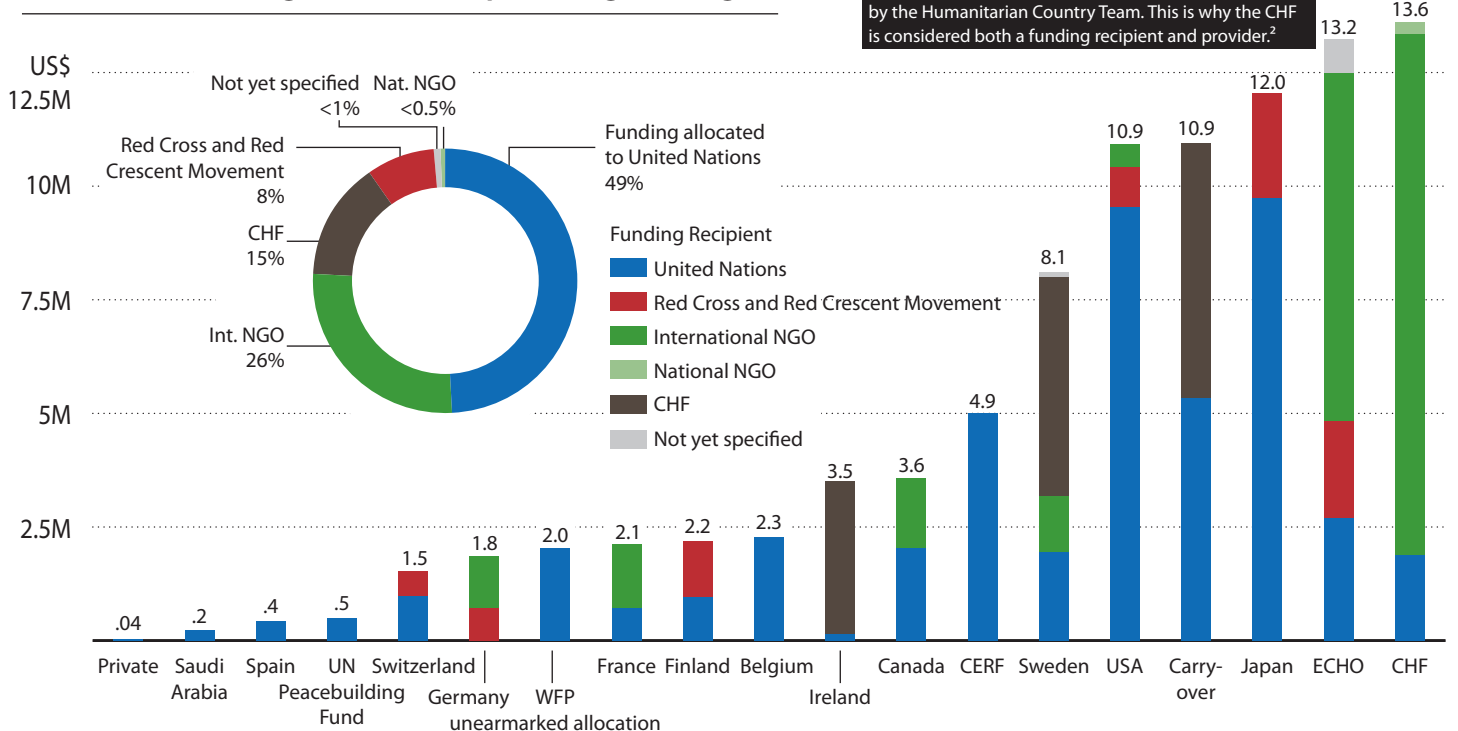
Sector to which funds are allocated

¹US\$16.6M include funding to ICRC, IFRC and MSF and other projects which are not part of the CAP. ²As with the CHF, the CERF is a funding mechanism that receives funds from donors which are then allocated to priority emergency and underfunded projects.
