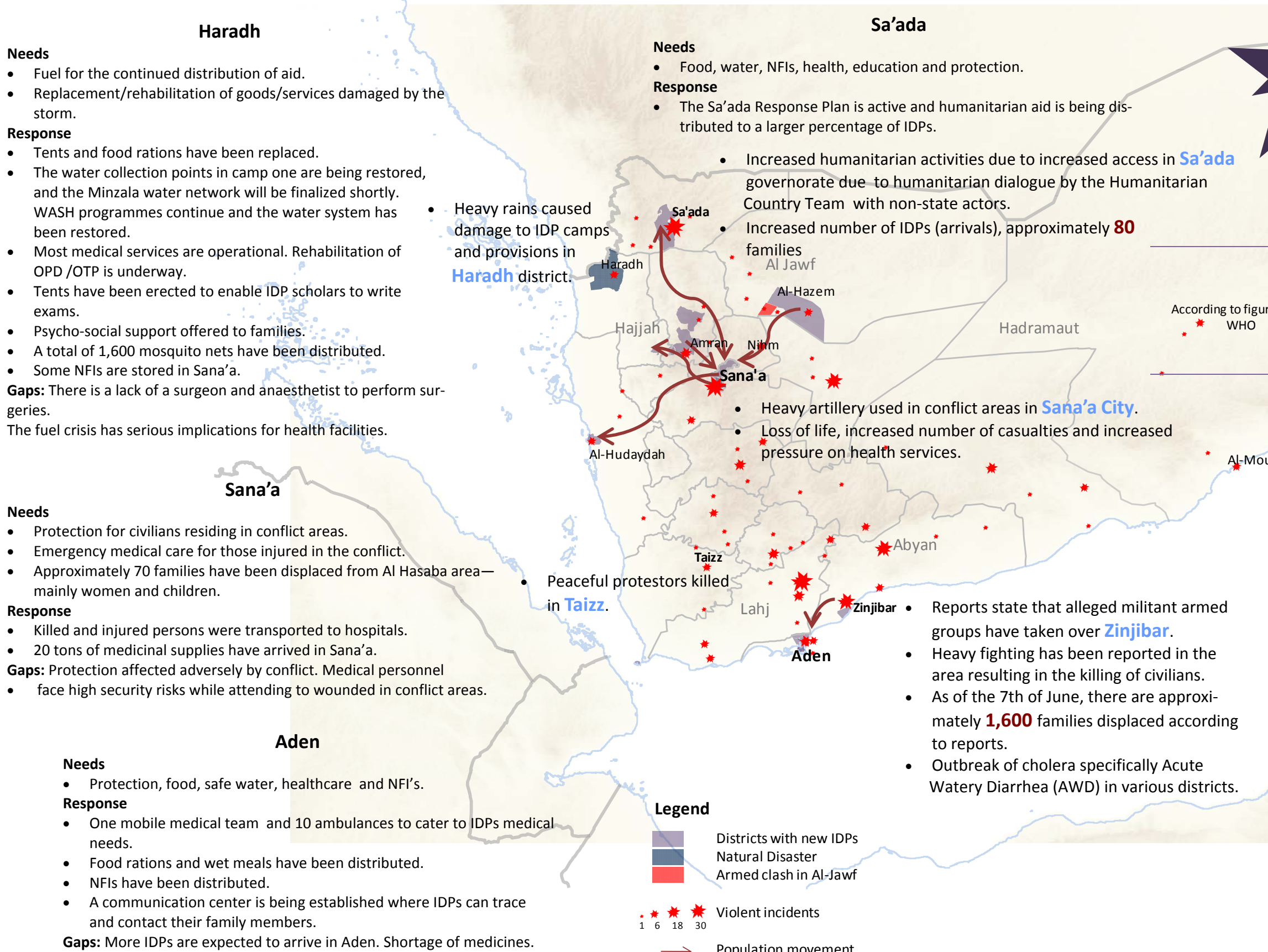
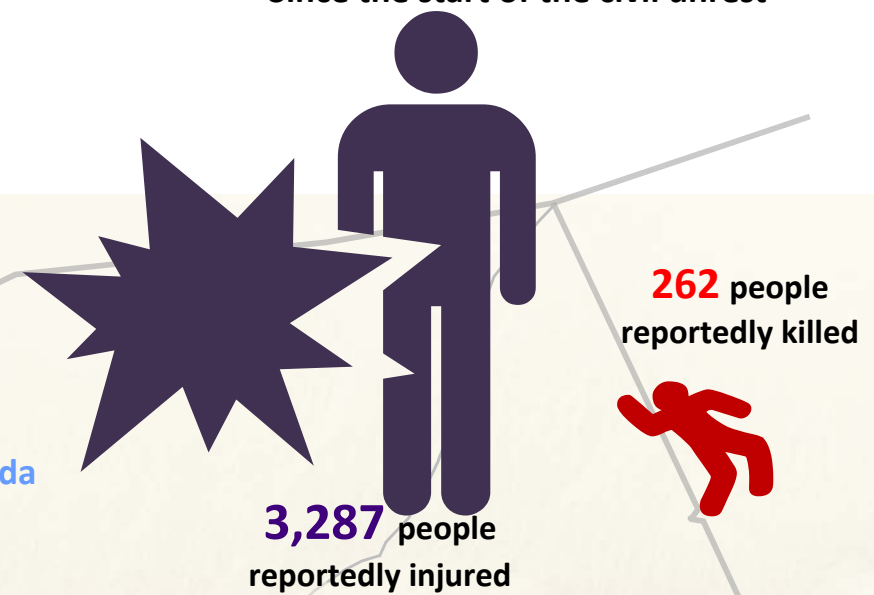


Yemen: Humanitarian snapshot as of 7th June 2011

The political situation in Yemen remains highly unstable. The escalation of clashes between government forces and tribes opposing President Saleh's regime has resulted in a sharp increase in death toll figures, persons injured and displacement. The security situation makes it difficult to ascertain the exact needs of all in Yemen, however humanitarian organizations are working collaboratively to respond to crises.

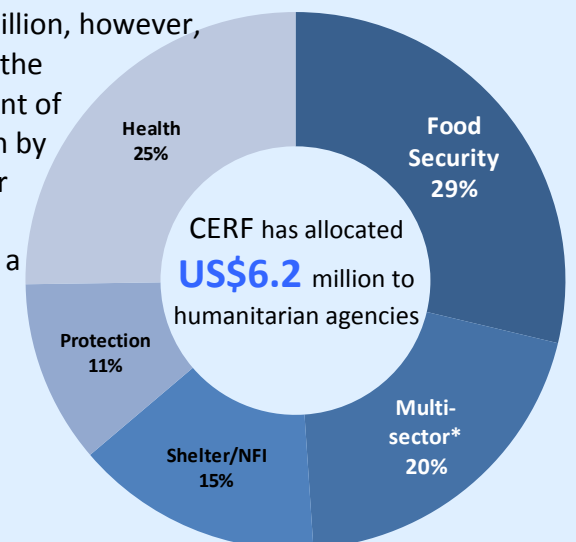

Humanitarian Response

The balance of the Emergency Response Fund (ERF) has increased and now totals **US\$ 5** million, which can be utilized by humanitarian actors upon successful applications in response to crises.

The original amount requested for the CAP was **US\$ 224** million, however, based upon the re-assessment of needs driven by the Mid Year Review it is estimated a further 30% is needed.
